The organisation was founded in 1924 by Emil Froeschels to foster collaboration of professionals interested in speech and voice disorder throughout the world.

International Organisation

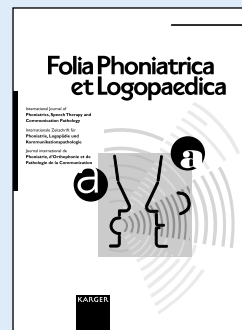
The IALP represents approximately 750,000 professionals in human communication through 57 affiliated societies in 38 countries throughout Africa, Asia, North and South America and Europe. In addition there are over four-hundred individual members around the globe.

The IALP has informative and consultative status (category B) with several United Nations Offices, such as UNESCO, WHO and UNICEF.

IALP Congresses

The IALP holds major congresses every three years in venues selected from around the world. Recent congresses have been held in Cairo, Egypt (1995), Amsterdam, The Netherlands (1998), Montreal, Canada (2001) and Brisbane, Australia (2004). Future congresses are planned for Copenhagen, Denmark (2007) and Athens, Greece (2010).

Scientific Journal



Folia Phoniatica et Logopaedica – the official publication of the IALP – is published since 1947. The journal reports scientific research and recent findings in the assessment and treatment of vocal function, speech and language disorders, literacy and swallowing disorders. The Garcia Prize is awarded triennially for the best article published in the journal over a three year period.
